##### DAPAANZ, Claire Aitken

- 78% of workforce
- 684 registered with DAPAANZ. 275 competent practitioners
- 800
- Otago DHB – staff member must be under HPCAA or registered social worker or competent practitioner registered with DAPAANZ.
- Working around those workers who have been in the field a long time without qualifications. DAPAANZ to introduce a support worker registration.
- Cultural competency
- Pacific Island competency

- All registered must reapply at the end of this year – will look for competencies for Pacific and Maori.
- Most work via email. First meeting in November.
- Matua Raki – addictions workforce development plan. Proposing scholarships for postgrad and under grad study.
- Available for particular training. Application comes from agency on behalf of applicant. Ongoing training plan submitted with application. If person does not complete the course, money must be refunded by the agency.
- DPAANZ has fielded formal complaints re AOD practitioners.

### Maori and Pacific Project for ODHB

- Project developed out of Mental Health Review.
- To ensure availability and access to appropriate MHS for Maori and other ethnic groups such as Pacific and Asian.
- Challenge to get info on Otago ethnicity data.
- Population data (2001 census). European and Maori as expected. Higher Numbers of PP 15 – 30 years.
- Range of demographic analysis presented.
- Data presented is only DHB provider services; no NGO.
- Consultation process longer than anticipated only because people wished to be included.
- Repeated message about looking at whanau not only at the individual.
- How the machinery would shift from individual to whanau is beyond scope of project.
- First draft completed by December. Consultation. Final draft middle of January.

### MHC

- Presentation of MHC framework for 2020 as presented at Leadership Day and discussed by NCAT – group feedback.
- Workforce specialists in AOD
- Model may be there but what about workforce
- Would gambling be there
- Discussion general rather than specific
- What would Maori think of this – consultation required. Looking to new Commissioner, Ray Watson, to bring Maori more effectively into MHC work planning.
