Service Introductions / News

Caroline House: There is a need for NA meetings in Timaru. Has had lots of referrals for young people from 17 years. *Timaru AOD Service:* New key worker Melonie secondment for 4 – 6 months. Information booklets available. *Public Health Timaru Hospital:* risky behaviour with youth noted. *Presbyterian Support:* Concern re the number of children witnessing violence. *Community Public Health:* provider for youth health and AOD. *Probation Service:* here to keep up with the play re AOD, young people are coming through courts, good to see services to refer to. *SF Aoraki* (Supporting families in Mental Illness): Nurse works with mid south families re Mental Health illness, getting a few referrals for dual diagnosis. *Adventure Development Company:* busy with an increase of young people. AOD and mental health older people ie 18ish also very young, primary school age, are being referred. *CYF:* under 17 year olds patterns of dual diagnosis, are sending these young people for detox. Hard core bunch. There is a lack of services for young people. *Women's Wellness:* Increasing number of young adult women coming in with injuries / bruises. They describe a high alcohol use and report no memory of how they got their injuries. *Centre Care Counselling, Waimate:* Seeing an increased number of people using prescription drugs and cannabis. Discussion re 'P' issue in the area. 'P' mixed with cannabis – it is a rumour.

Family, Consumer focus group working with registration – Consumer Advisor to set this up formally. Discussion re the need to have an NA support group.

More calls from people about their own alcohol use, particularly men. Previous years calls showed more from concerned others.
